ORDER

Exgratia Family pension has been sanctioned to the spouse only up to the date of remarriage or death whichever is earlier w.e.f 01/07/2014 vide ref(1) cited above. The expenditure towards the payment of exgratia family pension was met from the head of account "2071-01-105-99-(NV)-Family Pension". As the number of beneficiaries and the amount required for exgratia family pension has increased it is found necessary to open a new head of account to classify the expenditure.

Government have examined the proposal for opening a new head of account towards the payment of exgratia pension in detail and have opened a new head of account "2071-01-105-97-(NV)- Exgratia Family Pension" and a token provision has been earmarked under the head of account by satisfying 'New Service' procedure in the Supplementary Demands for Grants, June 2019.

Now Government are pleased to declare the Secretary/Principal Secretary/Additional Chief Secretary Finance Department as the Chief Controlling Officer for the newly opened head of account '2071-01-105-97(NV)- Exgratia Family Pension".
